MCARTHUR GLEN - YVR

When McArthurGlen Vancouver started Phase 3 of their already spectacularly popular designer outlet mall, we jumped at the opportunity to partner with this global empire. With a wayfinding system already designed and built, we were tasked with the challenge to replicate exactly what was already installed during Phase 1 and 2 of the build. Presented with a Graphic Standards package with UK specs, the challenge to sample existing signage, nail down its methodology and production process, and present a North American equivalent to their existing UK standards. Throughout the process our team made multiple visits to the Vancouver site to measure, photograph and compare our products to the existing ones.

Exterior signage had to be designed and built to withstand seismic and wind loads according to the National Building Code, which all required engineer approved drawings. Accessibility was also a big considerations when building some of the larger illuminated wayfinding map instillations. Powder coated aluminum, cut vinyl, painted and 3D hanging elements were all used throughout the project.

Visiting the beautifully crafted 2019 additions to the McArthurGlen Vancouver space will be effortless due in part to Astrographic's high-end wayfinding signage.



QUEST UNIVERSITY

Wayfinding System

Quest University Canada has around 700 students; 150 staff and faculty members. Presented with a government Grant, Quest's main focus with their wayfinding system was addressing their existing fragmented, challenging to read, and even in some cases falling apart system, with a main focus on accessibility.

Accessibility was addressed by using high contrast black and white treatments and a large bold typeface. Simplifying the sign design to mainly solid background colour and text also improved clarity for those visually impaired. Also included were tactile and Braille elements on specific wayfinding signs for elevators, washrooms and room labeling. These signs were installed at consistent heights throughout the campus to bring consistency to those who require them.


This well designed linear wayfinding system did more than help those visiting Quest University find their way through the campus. It continues to build confidence and trust, and reinforces the publics perception that Quest is a world class facility.










THE PORT OF VANCOUVER

Astrographic Industries' consolation and design team worked directly with members of the Port of Vancouver team as well as Ceres Corp. which manages the operation of the cruise ship terminal. Vancouver's cruise ship terminal poses some very unique challenges in that it utilizes up to 3 different floors, can have up to 4 ships in port at one time and needs to direct passengers through a check in procedure through each of these levels on occasion.

The Port needed a new theme, they needed to consolidate signage and make thing far easier for passengers to navigate each of the steps in order to embark and disembark from the cruise ships. As a team we helped develop the graphic standards, using a colour coded directional system as well as a bread-crumb procedure to reinforce where passengers need to be in order to make their boarding procedure as easy as possible.

After our design was so successful Astrographic was also awarded the contract to produce and install this new wayfinding system. In addition, Astrographic was awarded the task of designing, producing and installing a series of large wall murals the following year.

Donor Wall & Building Wayfinding


Astrographic has completed multiple signage jobs at the Jim Pattision Outpatient Care & Surgery Centre including a recently completed donor wall for the Surrey Hospital & Outpatient Centre Foundation. This custom design and build project included multiple printing and production techniques such as clear acrylic panels installed via chrome stand-offs, flop digital printed branded graphics, 3D CNC cut matte black acrylic letters, and cut vinyl.

Astrographic was also approached by the managing Fraser Health organization to design and manufacture a new wayfinding system for one of their busiest floors. This area of the facility was known by both staff and patients to be very confusing, as there were many steps to the patient experience and several different areas to navigate in order to find the right clinic. Illustrated on the next page is the wayfinding system designed to address all these navigational and informational challenges. Astrographic completed both the consulting and design phase as well as the production and installation of this entire system.









